Sunday services will be held at 9:30am and 11:00 am.

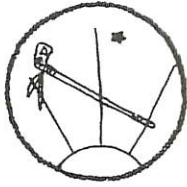

From North: Take 95 South to Route 4 South (Exit 8). Route 4 to Route 2. Stay on Route 2, you will come to a red light (Rte. 2 and 138) stay on 2. This will bring you to Old Mill Road on your right. There will be signs posted on Rte. 2 to bring you to the Indian Church Grounds.

From South: Take 95 South to Route 2 East. Right onto Route 78 East. Left onto Route 1 North. Take exit for URI off Route 1 North. This will put you on Route 2 North. Signs will be posted to bring you to Old Mill Road to the Indian Church Grounds.
